

Q1 Have you been exposed to COVID-19?


Q2 Have you tested positive for COVID-19?


Q3 Please mark all that applied to you when testing positive for COVID-19.





Q6 Do you think it would be helpful if the national guard took over the COVID-19 testing and vaccinations?





Q7 When the vaccine becomes available to you, will you get it?





Q8 Will you be required to take the vaccine by your employer?






Q10 If you are working short-staffed, please indicate any of the below that are the cause of the short-staffing?






